Report of the ESO Education Committee (1)

- The ESO summer school 2024 was organised from 16-20 September 2024 in Vilnius, Lithuania. It was very successful, and well attended event with excellent feedback. The next summer school will be organised on 22-26 September 2025 in Athens, Greece.
- The ESO focused workshop on rare causes of stroke took place in Ohrid, North Macedonia, on 12-14 April 2024. Participants were enthusiast and active and the event received a very positive feedback from the faculty and participants. The next one will be held on 13-14 March 2025 in Milan, Italy. It will focus on cerebral amyloid angiopathy, with 35 participants.
- The ESO Stroke Education platform (eSTEP) continues to increase its users. The platform has more than 1550 active users and 32.8% engagement rate. The platform is expanding towards more interactive exchanges and possibility of gaining CME credits. A call of interest will be circulated to National societies to provide new content.
- The online ESO Webinar series 4 continues and is planned until June 2025. The last webinar of 2024 was Headache and Stroke with a good attendance rate. Joint webinars were organised in 2024 and will be continued in 2025 (EAN, VAS, ESMINT, AHA, etc).
- The ESO Education Committee provided support to the ESO ESMINT Stroke Winter School team. The Edinburgh Stroke Research Workshop was successful in 2024 and the next edition is planned on 1-3 September 2025.
- Department to department visiting programme: 10 out of 31 applications were selected.
- ESO Emerging Leader Programme second edition: 3 winners out of 29 applicants from 18 different countries were selected.
- A White Paper on ESO Education Committee Activities will be circulated to all members for comments before submission to ESJ

- A collaboration between the Education Committee and the ESO Blog editors started in 2024. Report on each ESO webinar is planned in the ESO newsletter.
- VAS Atlas Project update in collaboration with VAS: all members are highly encouraged to volunteer and submit cases in the framework of the VAS Atlas project. Deadline to submit cases: 30 November 2025
- Moyamoya day: an international event endorsed by ESO with experts in Moyamoya arteriopathy was organised in Milan on December 13, with a very good feedback from participants. Report of this event will be included in the ESO newsletter.
